

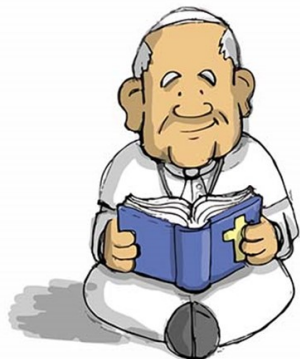
## What can I expect?

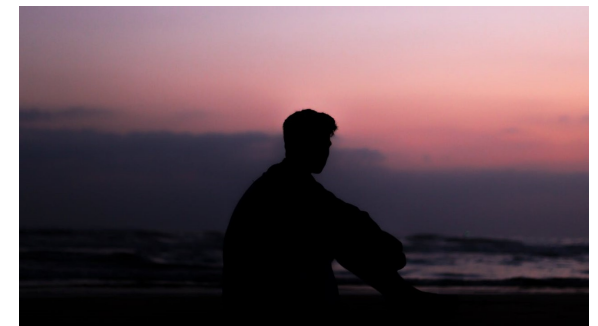
